

Dear LAHS Juniors and Seniors and Parents,

The LAHS 2018 Prom will be held on Saturday, May 19 at Buffalo Thunder Resort from 6:00 P.M to 11:00 P.M. This year's theme is "A Night in Paris: *La Vie En Rose*." Tickets are \$50 each and will be sold May 1 through May 11. We will also sell "late" tickets on May 14 and May 15, but the cost will increase to \$75 per ticket. We will not sell any tickets after 3:15 P.M. on May 15.

If your junior or senior wishes to bring a date who is not an LAHS junior or senior, your student must have a guest form filled out for her/his date in order to purchase the guest ticket. Mrs. Pacheco, in the Main Office, has the Prom Guest forms. No freshman may attend Prom, and the maximum age is 20.

If needed, we will provide transportation to and from LAHS to Buffalo Thunder in LAPS Suburbans. Students must sign-up for the transportation ahead of time. There will be a sign-up sheet available when students purchase their prom tickets.

Prom this year stars a three-course, French-inspired, plated meal. The first course consists of a spring green salad with sourdough croutons, parmesan cheese, and cherry tomatoes all topped with a peppercorn ranch dressing and a side of french rolls. The second course includes cordon bleu with crispy schnitzel chicken, cured ham, and swiss cheese; sauteed rapini and a roasted baby carrot; all lying on a bed of creamy mashed potatoes. The final course is a Chocolate Banana Royal dessert consisting of a chocolate tartlet with banana pudding and chocolate mousse. The cost of each ticket includes dinner which will be served from 7:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. Students must arrive by 6:45 PM at the latest if they wish to eat. Students with dietary constraints will be given the option of a vegan/vegetarian meal and will sign-up for that when they buy their prom tickets.

Music will be provided by *Party with TNT*, and students may make song requests through the *Party with TNT* Facebook Page, prior to and even during the dance at <https://www.facebook.com/PartyWithTNT/>. Our photographer for the evening will be LAHS's own Sal Zapien who will post the link to all the pictures so that students can print their own prom pictures.
