**The following items will be collected and used on an as-needed basis.**

- #2 sharpened wooden pencils – 2 dozen (replace as needed)
- 2 glue sticks
- Facial Tissue –2 boxes
- Wet wipes, antibacterial wipes, 2 containers
- 3 Packages pencil top erasers

**Label all items below with your child's first and last name.**

- 2 set of ear buds/earphones to use with laptop computer. (1 set for each classroom)
- Pencil sharpener (hand-held, mechanical)
- Colored pencils – 2 boxes
- Thin colored markers – 2 boxes
- 4 Highlighters – (including Pink, Yellow, Green)
- 1 package red pens and 1 package blue pens
- 8 Dry Erase (fine-point, low odor markers)
- 4 Pocket folders **with brads**–(to include 1 blue, 1 red, 1 yellow, and 1 green)
- 1 Pocket folder for music-(third grade only)
- 2 Pocket folders, plastic coated- any color
- 1 spiral notebook wide rule for language arts
- 1 **Graph composition** notebook for math
- 1 **Lined composition** notebook for language arts
- 2 Large zipper pencil bags
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 Ruler, plastic w/standard & metric measurement
- 1 package graph paper

**Optional items to support classroom**

Ziploc bags any size

Dry erase markers

Wooden pencils

Pencil top erasers

Colored pens (red, green, purple, etc...)

### **Emergency Kit**

As part of the School Safety Plan, all students are expected to have a two-day supply of food and medications should a shelter in place incident occur.

Emergency Kit: Place recommended contents (nothing that leaks or spoils) in a gallon-sized zip-lock bag, sealed, with student name, teacher and grade written on bag:

- ❖ One 16 oz bottle water
- ❖ One juice box
- ❖ 4-5 non-perishable food items such as: canned fruit, tuna, or pasta in individual pouches or cans with pull off lids-that can be eaten cold; fruit snacks, granola bars, beef jerky, cheese or peanut butter crackers, package cookies
- ❖ Comfort items such as: family picture and/or note from parents
- ❖ Special treat and small comfort toy that **fits in bag**
- ❖ Individual medications with doctor's permission slip (medications they cannot be without for 2 days)

These items will be returned at the end of the school year
