

## TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT - STUDENT BUS RULES

1. Behave in an orderly safe manner.
2. Arrive at the bus stop five minutes prior to the scheduled time for the bus to arrive.
3. Wait in a safe place, clear of traffic and away from where the bus stops.
4. Wait in an orderly line and avoid horseplay.
5. Cross the road or street ten feet in front of the bus upon direction of the driver.
6. Go directly to assigned seat when entering the bus and face forward.
7. Remain seated and keep aisles and exits clear.
8. Observe classroom conduct and obey the driver promptly and respectfully, follow directions the first time they are given.
9. Refrain from the use of profane language, tobacco, alcohol, drugs or any other controlled substance.
10. Do not throw or pass objects on, from or into buses.
11. Students are permitted to carry on objects that can be held on their lap.
12. All items that would readily roll on a flat surface, such as balls, cans and objects with wheels, shall be carried in a bag while on the bus.
13. Do not carry hazardous materials, nuisance items or animals onto the bus.
14. Do not eat or drink on the bus.
15. Respect the rights and safety of others. Fighting or abusing other passengers can lead to immediate suspension.
16. Do not leave or board the bus at locations other than the assigned stops at home or school.
17. Drivers are instructed not to stop the bus or load students once they have closed the doors in preparation to move forward.
18. Do not extend head, arms or objects out of the windows.
19. Use headphones or ear buds on all personal audio devices, students will remove headphones or ear buds when entering or exiting the bus.
